Renewal of Partnership between ICANN and KISA

Dear Hyun O,

In November 2013, ICANN and KISA entered into a Memorandum of Understanding ('ICANN-KISA MoU') to foster collaboration between our organizations; and ICANN and KISA signed an Exchange of Letters on 6 November 2019 in furtherance of the objective of the ICANN-KISA MoU. We continue to appreciate our ongoing cooperative relationship and collaboration with KISA.

We thank KISA for your continuing commitment to furthering our collaboration with the support of the Korea Network Information Center ('KRNIC'). We look forward to the next phase of our cooperative efforts in relation to the Internet's unique identifier systems, as well as engaging with the Asia Pacific (APAC) community on Internet governance aspects.

ICANN understands that KRNIC, in partnership with the ICANN APAC Regional Office, will carry out specifically, though not limited to, the following activities:

- Enhance the operations of the Asia Pacific Internet Governance Academy ('APIGA'), and explore potential globalization of the APIGA program;
- Engage with the wider Korean Internet community on Internationalized Domain Names (IDNs) and Universal Acceptance (UA);
- Identify opportunities to conduct capacity-building programs for regional members of the Governmental Advisory Committee (GAC) and promote regional GAC participation in Internet governance discussions;
- Support ICANN contracted parties in Korea, particularly in bridging language and knowledge gaps; and
- Explore new areas of collaboration, particularly in technical areas supporting the security, stability, and resiliency of the Internet's unique identifier system.

ICANN understands that KRNIC staff are in charge of the above mentioned collaborative activities with the ICANN APAC Regional Office. Nothing under this arrangement constitutes them as agents and/or employees of ICANN for any purpose whatsoever.

The commitments in this letter will take effect on 13 March 2023 ('Effective Date'). ICANN commits to collaborate with KISA for 24 (twenty-four) months from the Effective Date. If KISA and ICANN wish to continue collaborating at the end of this 24-month period, we can agree to do so.



ICANN understands that the partnership activities with KISA are non-exclusive, and either KISA or ICANN can work with other relevant organizations on areas of mutual interest per the objectives of the ICANN-KISA MoU.

ICANN understands that ICANN and KISA are each responsible for the use of its own funds or funding sources to perform our respective responsibilities for joint projects, in a mutually agreeable manner.

In furtherance of our work, ICANN understands there may be times when press releases, public announcements or public statements regarding that work may be appropriate. ICANN agrees that such statements and announcements should only be released upon consent of both parties, which consent should not be unreasonably withheld. ICANN commits to only use KISA's logo with KISA's written consent, and, if approached to sign a Trademark License agreement governing such use, ICANN shall do so. ICANN thanks KISA for its commitment to the use of ICANN's trademarks only with ICANN's prior written consent, and pursuant to the terms of Trademark License Agreement if requested by ICANN.

Should either party find its cooperation no longer possible on the terms identified in this letter, ICANN agrees that either party may rescind its commitments reflected in this Exchange of Letters upon 60-days' written notice.

Nothing contained in this letter shall give rise to any liability, monetary or otherwise, by either one to the other.

We look forward to continuing our long and mutually beneficial relationship with KISA.
