Discussion Topics from RrSG

Issues registrars are seeing

- *Inconsistent handling on similar issues*
 - Evidence of fraud in transfer complaints is assessed on a case-by-case basis and review of information and evidence provided by registrar
- *Failure to provide timely updates*
 - Compliance communications and updates sent to relevant RADAR contacts when available or requested
- *Naming Services portal does not display complete list of open tickets*
 - Current list of compliance tickets is in NSp and development of NSp for compliance ticket processing is underway

Discussion Topics from RrSG

Issues related to privacy laws

- *Enforcement over redaction of Registrant Organization field*
 - Temporary Specification does not change requirement to display Registrant Organization key/value in WHOIS
- *Requests for personal data*
 - ICANN requests data necessary for its review and determination of a contracted party's compliance with the ICANN requirements
 - Complaints may be resolved even if ICANN is unable to determine compliance (primary mission)
- *Metrics on Temp Spec-related complaints*
 - See following slides

Temporary Specification Metrics

Temporary Specification related complaint - reporting

- Approximately 716 complaints related to Temporary Specification since 25 May 2018
 - Majority closed after educating reporters on requirements
- Approximately 30 registrars and 5 registries received compliance inquiries/notices
 - Over half completed remediation or are currently remediating
 - Approximately 5 registrars challenged requirements and are continuing to collaborate with ICANN
 - Remainder in process

Discussion Topics from RrSG

General policy issues

- *Change to registrant data for a domain using P/P services*
 - Transfer Policy: registrants must be able to transfer domains between registrars where not prohibited by ICANN or registry
 - Denial of transfer for undefined lock is prohibited
 - See definitions of privacy and proxy services, change of registrant (COR)
 - Formal correspondence published on ICANN's website

Discussion Topics from RrSG

Update on timing/scope of next registrar audit

- Next registrar audit targeted to begin after conclusion of current registry audit
- Scope will be DNS infrastructure abuse and tied to the information gathered during the registry audit
