The following additional terms and conditions apply to registrations in the .XXX TLD.

- By registering a <u>Domain Name</u>, <u>Registrant</u> represents and warrants: It is either an <u>Authorized Proxy Service</u> or a business, entity, individual, or organization that: (i) has voluntarily determined that a system of self-identification would be beneficial, and (ii) has voluntarily agreed to comply with all <u>IFFOR Policies</u> and <u>Best Practices Guidelines</u>, as published from time to time on the <u>IFFOR web site</u>; and (ii) either:
  - Provides online, sexually-oriented adult entertainment ("Online Adult Entertainment") intended for consenting adults or for other community members ("Providers"):
  - Represents Providers ("Representatives"); or
  - Provides products or services to Providers and Representatives ("Service Providers").
- If registrant is a Provider, Representative, or Service Provider, in registering this name in the .XXX TLD, Registrant represents and warrants that it has used a <u>Verification Credential</u> acquired directly from ICM Registry or an ICM-Authorized Authentication Provider in connection with the ICM Verification Process, as set forth on the ICM Registry website at www.ICM.xxx.
- 3. - 5. Registrant agrees to comply with applicable <u>ICANN</u> requirements, standards, policies, procedures, and practices for which ICM has monitoring responsibility in accordance with the <u>Registry Agreement</u> or other arrangement with ICANN.
- 6. Registrant represents and warrants that it has provided current, accurate and complete information in connection with its registration of the Domain Name and its creation, launch, and operation, including but not limited to information required for the purposes of the Whois records. Registrant agrees to immediately correct and update the registration information for the Domain Name during the registration term for the Domain Name. Registrant further

consents to the use, copying, distribution, publication, modification and other processing of all such information by Registry Operator as necessary to process the registration for the Domain Name, operate the .XXX TLD, and comply with its obligations under law and the Registry Agreement.

- Registrant acknowledges and agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of the initial launch and general operations of the .xxx TLD, including as applicable to the Registrant and including, without limitation, the <u>Start Up Trademark Opposition Process</u>, <u>the Limited Launch</u>, the <u>Premium Name Allocation Process</u>, and general registration.
- 10. Registrant acknowledges and agrees that if the Domain Name is a Premium Name, then use of the Domain Name is also subject to the terms and conditions of the ICM Premium Name Agreement, which is incorporated by reference herein. Registrant further acknowledges and agrees that upon termination or expiration of the Premium Name Agreement in accordance with the terms thereof: (i) any and all rights of Registrant to the Domain Name, the Verification Credential, and/or to create, launch, and/or operate the a website using the Domain Name shall be terminated, and all such rights shall revert to Registry Operator, and Registry Operator may offer right to the Domain Name, the Registration Code to any entity or person in its sole discretion, and Registrant shall have no rights or recourse against Registry Operator, Registry Service Provider, IFFOR, ICANN, and/or Registrar relating to the registration or use of the Domain Name and/or Registration Code for the Domain Name by any other such entity or person.

This indemnification obligation shall survive the termination or expiration of the registration agreement.

This Agreement and its interpretation and all disputes between the parties arising in any manner hereunder, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of New York, without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the State of New York or any other jurisdiction) that would cause the application of laws of any jurisdictions other than those of the State of New York.
