1 – Accredited Registrar Status (Appendix 4, Item 1)

Table 1 states the number of Registrars for whom VeriSign has received accreditation notification from ICANN at the end of the reporting month, grouped into the three categories:

- 1. Operational Registrars: Those who have authorized access into the Shared Registration System (SRS) for processing domain name registrations.
- 2. Registrars In The Ramp-Up Period: Those who have received a password to access the Registry operational test and evaluation (OT&E) environment. The OT&E environment is provided to allow registrars to develop and test their systems with the SRS.
- 3. Registrars In The Pre-Ramp-Up Period: Those who have been sent a welcome letter from VeriSign but have not yet executed the Registrar Agreements and/or have not yet submitted a completed Registrar Information Sheet. In most cases registrars are sent welcome letters via overnight express mail or e-mail on the same day accreditation notification is received from ICANN.
