Dear Sir, Madam,

By our registry agreement entered into as of June 18th, 2015, ICANN has designated us as the registry operator for the Top-Level Domain ".mutuelle".

The article 4.4 (Termination by Registry Operator) of this registry agreement provides that "(b) Registry Operator may terminate this Agreement for any reason upon one hundred eighty (180) calendar day advance notice to ICANN".

Hereby, we inform you of our decision to implement the provisions of this article and accordingly terminate our registry agreement.

This termination will therefore take effect after a period of one hundred eighty (180) calendar day from today's date.

For all purposes, we inform you that there no registrants in the Top-Level Domain ".mutuelle".

In this regard, could you please let us know if you would agree that we put an end to the letter of credit granted in your favor by our bank, Crédit Agricole, considering that, as stipulated on the gtld applicant guide book (page 137/338), this letter of credit has been granted only "for the protection of registrants in the new gTLD".

Likewise, we thank you in advance for confirming that ICANN has not implemented this letter of credit.
