Please be advised that, as of 28 June 2022, Domainia Inc. ("Domainia" or "Registrar") 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 10 September 2018 ("RAA") is terminated pursuant to Section 5.5.4 of the RAA. The termination shall become effective 14 July 2022,16 calendar days from the date of this Termination Notice pursuant to the terms of the RAA.

The termination is due to Domainia's failure to timely cure the breaches by 19 May 2022 as set forth in ICANN's Notice of Breach of RAA dated 28 April 2022. As of 28 June 2022, the following breaches remain:

1. Domainia's failure to timely pay past due accreditation fees, as required by Section 3.9 of the RAA.

Additionally, Domainia has failed to:

- 2. Provide ICANN with the corrective and preventative action(s) that Domainia will take, with implementation date(s), to: (a) address its pattern of untimely responses to ICANN Contractual Compliance matters; and (b) to ensure it has provided ICANN with accurate and current contact information.
- 3. After curing all items in the 28 April 2022 Notice of Breach, provide a certificate executed by the president, chief executive officer, chief financial officer or chief operating officer (or their equivalents) of Domainia certifying compliance with the terms and conditions of the RAA ("compliance certificate").

Domain Name Transition Process

As of the date of this Termination Notice, Domainia does not manage any gTLD domain name. Therefore, ICANN does not need to invoke the De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure.

ICANN Logo License

Domainia is further advised that the logo license granted in the Logo License Specification to the RAA is revoked as of 14 July 2022. Please remove all ICANN trademarks, name, and logo from Domainia's website and business materials that have been licensed to Domainia under the terms of that Specification by 14 July 2022.

ICANN reserves all of its rights under the RAA. Please note the rights and obligations required to continue in effect after the expiration of the RAA, including but not limited to: Sections 3.4 Retention of Registered Name Holder and Registration Data; 3.9 Accreditation Fees; 5.8 Resolution of Disputes Under this Agreement; and 5.9 Limitations on Monetary Remedies for Violations of this Agreement.

Domainia has current and past due accreditation fees. Please immediately submit payment to ICANN Accounting.
